Advanced Class

Suitable for those who do not have the energy for the above class but can consistently execute all steps and formations to a high standard showing good phrasing, use of hands, covering and who can sustain this level of performance, independently, throughout the entire period of the class.

Advanced Low Impact Social Class

Class suitable for competent dancers with a good knowledge of steps and formations who want a low impact class focussing on sociability and overall execution of dances

Intermediate Class
